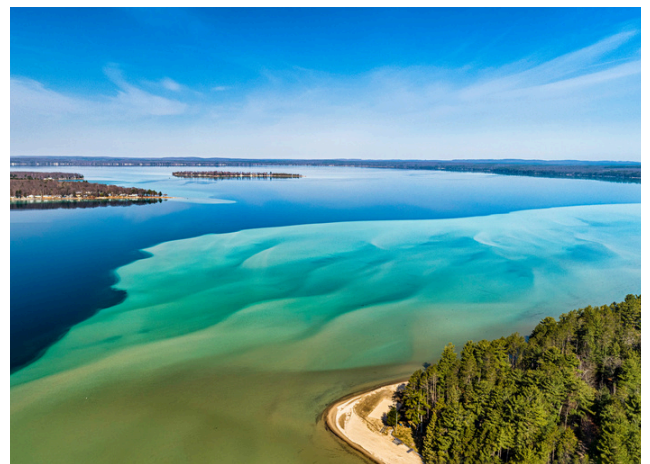
Gerrish Township Launches HOHL

Health of Higgins Lake (HOHL) initiative will take a broad approach to lake health examining the full spectrum of potential contributors to lake conditions, including

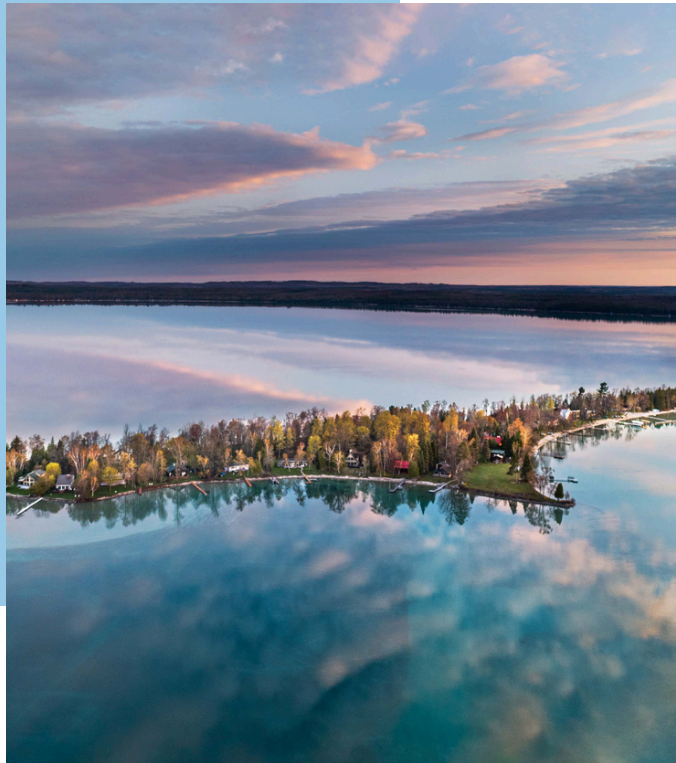
- road runoff,

determine information technology configuration, accounting, and grant application strategy

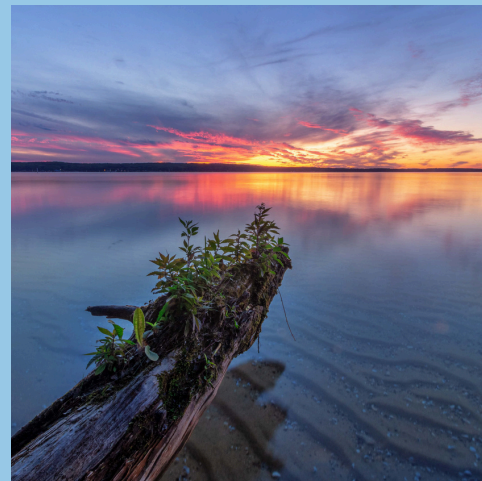
HOHL Committees
