ROAD END COMMITTEE

This committee will evaluate road-end runoff that is causing contamination of the lake and will work with the Roscommon County Road Commission (RCRC) to determine potential solutions and associated costs. It will also research fertilizer bans or ordinance documents from other communities and present them to the steering committee for consideration.

The Road End Committee has actively assessed numerous Gerrish Township road ends for concerns such as water runoff, erosion, and clogged storm drains.

Additionally, GPS coordinates have been established for the road ends in Gerrish Township. Efforts are underway to provide GPS coordinates for the Lyon Township road ends as well.

The Road End Committee is also reviewing past reports related to Higgins Lake and the data contained in those reports.
