survey in the future.
3. IT: Report was submitted. Panyard reports they are working a rolling funding
resource calendar on NextCloud. Committee would like additional funding for
projects that are not currently on the EGLE Grant estimate.
Funding: Report was submitted.

4. Roads: Report was submitted. O'Rourke reports that all the data has been collected for the Road Ends but suggested some of the parallel roads should be included in the report. It was decided to include them as an addendum. Committee would also like to see water testing at the road ends in the future. They will meet with Roscommon Road Commission to discuss future work on the road ends to mitigate erosion into the lake. They are in the process of digitizing the data collected.
5. Septic: Report was submitted. Ostling reports committee is in the process of drafting a septic ordinance. Once the draft is complete it will be forwarded to Gerrish Township Board. Once approved by the Board it will be forwarded to Planning Commission to make the formal ordinance.

Teresa Berde Korn asked if the request of \$40,000 from the EGLE grant was the maximum allowed. Ostling replied that the \$40,000 was the maximum allowed. Teresa Berde Korn asked if there is a plan for funding if we are denied the grant. Ostling replied we will keep looking for funding elsewhere.
